"Deepen your overall hair look with a dimensional color using mulberry and violet tones. Have your colorist choose a few violet shades and alternate them throughout for an illuminating end result. Sweep your hair off your face. Style your hair with a pompadour fringe and sleek sides for a fresh fall look."

"This fall [in makeup] is all about bright colors, either on the eyes or the lips, with metallic touches. Try a brown neutral smoky eye with a bold berry lip or a pop of color on the eyes with a pink lip. To balance out your choice of a bold eye or lip, you will want to play down your cheek color. Try applying a light contour from the top of your ear to the corner of your lip and blend in a peach-toned blush. Finish off your look with a sweep of highlight on your cheekbones and the inner corners of your eyes."
